Harold Schubert the owner of SchubArt, brought along a sample of all their Acrylic Colours, which the members got to experiment with.

Harold gave a talk on their brands of Acrylic paints, Mediums, Glazes, Modelling paste, Gels Gesso and primer.

There were samples of their Acrylic paints which members were given as well as a demonstration.





The interaction with the members was fun and informative. Harold also explained the different applications between their Gesso and Primer. Alan Nell the Schub Paints sales manager, was on hand to explain how you can achieve different finishes, just by adding a small amount of water.

Although it was the Easter weekend, we still had a great turnout.







☐ FELLOWS OF THE SOCIETY

How to become a Fellow and what it means: -

First and foremost, ongoing participation in Selection Weekend is crucial.

Every year, in August, SASA organises a weekend during which members are invited to submit three artworks for judging by three independent art experts who assign points, between 1-10, to each work. It is the points scored at this event that contribute to the achievement of Fellowship of the Society.


Artists need to score points of 75% or more per artwork. Points scored over 4 consecutive years are taken into account, and the best 3 out of those 4 years go towards Fellowship potential.

Senior Fellows and Master Fellows are promoted through the ranks of the Fellows are calculated on the same basis. To that effect, it can take up to 9 years to become a Master Fellow.

Fellows are invited to submit additional artworks, free of charge at every exhibition, Conditions of Entry pertaining. A Fellow of the Society is entitled to use the post-nominal letters "FSASA"; a Senior Fellow "SFSASA" and a Master Fellow "MFSASA".

The society looks to the Fellows, for their continued support and participation in exhibitions and competitions, to be a source of encouragement for the members in their growth and confidence as artists towards their own pursuance of Fellowship.


